Project Scope




Cove, the project will widen Highway 62 in the urban section of Shady Cove between Rogue River Drive and Cleveland Street. The project will construct a two-way, center turn lane and provide sidewalks, bike lanes and storm sewer.

Sidewalks will be constructed on both sides of the highway between Rogue River Drive and Williams Lane. Sidewalks will be built on only the west side between Williams Lane and Cleveland Street.

Jackson County is also funding a right turn lane for Rogue River Drive, which will be included in this project.

In April, ODOT Survey crews are scheduled to be on site to establish right of way lines which will determine the design impacts. Afterward, ODOT will be coordinating with property owners to address project and existing or future driveway issues.
